




## Analog HD Camera Quick Start Guide

- Please read this instruction carefully before operating the unit and keep it for further reference.
- All the examples and illustrations used here are for reference only.
- The contents of this manual are subject to change without notice.

### 1.Warning and Caution

- If the product does not work properly, please contact your dealer or the nearest service center. Never attempt to disassemble the camera yourself. (We shall not be responsible for any problems caused by unauthorized repair or maintenance.)
  - Do not allow water or liquid intrusion into the camera.
  - During use of the product, you must strictly comply with the electrical safety regulations. The product needs to be firmly fixed/mounted on wall/ceiling.
  - Do not use camera beyond specified voltage range.
  - Do not drop the camera or subject it to physical shock.
- If cleaning is necessary, please use clean cloth to wipe it gently. If the device is not to be used for a long time, please cover the camera to protect from dirt.
- Do not point the camera at the sun or extra bright place directly.
  - Do not place the camera in extremely hot, cold, dusty or damp locations, and do not expose it to high electromagnetic radiation.
  - To avoid heat accumulation, good ventilation is required for operating environment.




Bullet or Dome Camera




Plastic plug × 3


### 3.Bullet Camera Overview & Installation



- Fix the bracket to the wall with screws.




- Adjust the viewing angle. Loosen the screws to adjust the angle(A for vertical angle, B for axial angle)



- Tighten the screws with hex wrench to complete the installation.

### 4.Dome Camera Overview & Installation



- Swing the bottom cover to the right.

- Secure the bottom cover with 4 screws to the top wall
- Adjust the viewing angle.

- Screw the main body into the base to complete the installation.
